Creative Empowerment Opportunities will provide all Person Served with a picture I.D. to wear while at the program/community which will stay at the building at the end of each day. The I.D. has letters that indicate any special level of care or assistance needed for the individual person:
















To ensure your safety. Creative Empowerment Opportunities has a Transportation Profile with all pertinent safety concerns while receiving transportation services. Information included on the profile are a copy of the persons served CEO ID including the applicable seatbelt assistance code, any special seating accommodations, home address, phone number and a map to the persons served home. A Transportation Profile is located in each Vehicle Manual for the transporter to access important information quickly.
